This non-binding Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") entered into effective as of date:,

Electronics & ICT Academy (Phase II), located at Pandit Dwarka Prasad Mishra Indian Institute of Information Technology, Design and Manufacturing, Jabalpur (hereafter referred as E&ICT ACADEMY-PII) having its registered office at Dumna Airport Road, Jabalpur 482005

And

Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Guna MP 473226, hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "E&ICTJ Partner".

Electronics & ICT Academy (Phase II), located at Pandit Dwarka Prasad Mishra Indian Institute of Information Technology, Design and Manufacturing, Jabalpur (IIITDMJ), is set up through a project grant by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, for capacity building and enhancement of employability in Electronics, Information & Communication Technology and related areas.

Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology (JUET), Guna has been established vide Government of Madhya Pradesh gazette extra ordinary No.3 of 2010 dated 29th April 2010 as a private university in the State of MP under the provisions of MP Niji Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam 2007. The university has been notified by the UGC under section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 and Accredited by NAAC with Grade "A+" in 2nd Cycle in 2023.

This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ("MOA") sets forth certain binding and non-binding understandings, is effective as of the later of the dates in the signature block ("Effective Date"), and is made and entered into by and between E&ICTJ PARTNER and E&ICT ACADEMY-PII, in

furtherance of their mutual interest, in the fields of training, education, and as a contribution to increased national cooperation between the E&ICTJPARTNER having its registered address at Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Raghogarh, Guna MP 473226 and the E&ICT Academy PII, having its registered office at PDPM IIITDM Jabalpur, Dumna Airport Road, Jabalpur, Pin Code – 482005.

A. Association

The agreement between the parties involves collaboration between the E&ICTJ Partner and the E&ICT Academy PII in related disciplines. The two organizations shall seek to promote:

- 1. Collaboration in training (either in kind or on paid basis) as per the mutual agreement, based on the subject, type (basic, advanced and research-oriented), and duration of the courses in the areas of Electronics, Information & Communication Technology, and related areas. The courses might be conducted multiple times with academic participation as per the mutual convenience.
- 2. The E&ICT Academy PII and E&ICT Partner will broadly collaborate in the following areas
 - a. Participation in the development of courses and training modules for enhancing the capabilities of teachers with the main objective of enhancing the skills and employability of students.
 - b. Cooperation in training programs and related activities of mutual interest.
 - c. Participation in seminars, workshops, and other types of academic discussions.
- 3. E&ICT Academy PII's specific training programs or courses will be promoted and hosted with the active participation of the E&ICTJ Partner.
- 4. E&ICT Academy PII and the E&ICTJ Partner will jointly run faculty development programmes (FDPs), for which the grant-in-aid received by E&ICT Academy PII will be shared with the E&ICTJ Partner, on pro-rata basis.
- 5. The students' skill development programmes will be jointly organized in the self-sustainable mode, for which the GST, if any, will be paid by the E&ICTJ Partner, if the programme is conducted in the premises of E&ICT Partner.
- 6. The two parties agree to share the revenue generated by registration fee or through any other source of income for the programmes jointly organized in the premises of E&ICTJ Partner with the proportion of share based on mutual agreement.

- 7. The E&ICTJ partner will facilitate the following to run joint activities on their premises.
 - a. Local assistance in running labs and providing hands-on experience to participants of a training programme or similar activity.
 - b. The infrastructure support required for running joint FDPs or any other activity for accommodating at least 50 participants.
 - c. Distribution of publicity banners and posters with approval of the authorities from E&ICT Academy PII and E&ICTJ Partner.
 - d. Accommodation for experts and E&ICT Academy staff, whenever a joint activity is organized at the premises of E&ICTJ Partner.
 - e. Accommodation (guest rooms/hostels) for the participants on subsidized rates, payment will be made by the E&ICT Academy PII.
- 8. The E&ICT Academy PII reserves explicit right to choose partners for training programmes and other activities.
- 9. The E&ICT Academy PII will be solely responsible for identifying courses which will be conducted throughout the year in association with E&ICTJ Partners.
- 10. Any changes, if made, in the mode of collaboration and operations, will be through mutual consent of E&ICTJ Partner and the E&ICT Academy PII.
- 11. E&ICTJ Partner and the E&ICT Academy PII will jointly publicize/advertise the joint programmes or activities to be conducted.
- 12. Neither the E&ICTJ Partner will use the logo and name of the E&ICT Academy PII nor the E&ICT Academy PII will use the name or logo of the E&ICTJ Partner for any type of publicity or promotion other than that for joint activities.

B. Implementation

The implementation of cooperation based on this Memorandum shall be dealt with between both the Institutions. Where necessary, a specific plan shall be worked out for each activity setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration. Such plans shall be subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities of each Institution. To facilitate the development of such plans, each Institution shall nominate a member of its staff to coordinate activities arising under this agreement.

C. Confidentiality

Both Institutions agree and undertake to always keep confidential any information and/or data that may be exchanged, acquired and/or shared in connection with the area of cooperation as mentioned above in 'ARTICLE A' unless otherwise the same information already exists in the public domain.

D. Publication

Ownership of any research findings shall be vested in both parties to this Memorandum and any publications regarding the same shall only be possible after prior approval from both parties.

E. Duration

The Memorandum shall remain in force up to 31-3-2026, commencing from the date of signing, and may be reviewed by mutual consent by serving 03 (Three) months written notice to the other party. Upon renewal, both parties shall select either to proceed with the existing or new terms of understanding.

F. Termination

Both the E&ICTJ Partner and the E&ICT Academy PII, reserve the right to terminate this Memorandum by either party giving 3 (Three) months written notice to the other. Where such termination occurs, the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to ongoing activities until their completion.

G. Arbitration

In the event of any dispute or difference at any time arising between the parties relating to the joint activities or any other clause (s) or any content of the right and liabilities of the parties or other matters specified therein or with reference to anything arising out of the project or otherwise in relation to the terms, whether during the active period of MOU or thereafter, such dispute or difference shall be endeavored to be resolved by mutual negotiations. If, however, such negotiations are infructuous the dispute should be finally settled through the arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 by three arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said Act. The arbitrators shall give reasoned and speaking award. The place of arbitration could be mutually decided by the parties.

Participating staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the host countries and the rules and regulations of the host institutions.
